

MONOLITH RANCH HUNTER MANAGEMENT AREA

Open August 15, 2024 thru December 31, 2024 for the take of **Antelope** in hunt area **37 or 44** and **white-tailed deer** in hunt area **77, on City of Laramie property only** during specific seasons as published in the 2024 Game and Fish Commission Regulations

GENERAL RULES:

- Each hunter must possess a valid permission slip while in the field.
- Each hunter must display a valid vehicle pass in the window.
- Hunting is foot and horseback only.
- Use certified weed free hay for your horses while on the ranches.
- Leave gates as you find them. (Close gates behind you)
- Non-hunting, non-permitted persons may accompany a permitted hunter with a valid permission slip and do not possess a bow or firearm.
- No overnight camping and campfires.
- GPS/Mapping Service is highly recommended when accessing this property.
- **No littering**—carry out everything you bring in.

RESTRICTIONS

- No taking of ANY OTHER SPECIES (including predators) or any other activities (including collecting antlers, hiking, etc.) without landowner written permission.
- Preseason scouting is not allowed.
- Access within closed areas (see map) is not allowed.
- Driving on closed roads or behind closed area gates is not allowed.
- Any commercial activity, including outfitting or guiding is not allowed.
- Do not shoot in the direction of livestock, roads, fences or buildings. No shooting within 200 yards of buildings or livestock. Must be unloaded around the vicinity of all vehicles and buildings.
- Do not damage fences, range improvements or harass livestock.
- No travel through HMA for the take of wildlife not listed on permission slip.

The Monolith Ranch HMA SPECIFIC RULES:

- One permission slip will allow a hunter with multiple licenses to take additional animals of the same species, provided the permission slip is less restrictive than the license. (additional doe/fawn antelope licenses may be filled by a holder of a single “any” antelope permission slip. But a buck whitetail may not be taken by a doe/fawn permission slip holder.)
- Use or construction of blinds is prohibited.
- Anyone without Department permission or failure to display the vehicle permission pass on their dash shall be subject to trespass charges.
- Access only during dates specified on permission slip for current year.
- Drive on **designated** roads only. (Marked by white arrow)
- Abide by all signs and posted areas.
- **Violation** of Ranch Rules will result in denial of their access to HMA in subsequent years.
- Hunters are urged to use **lead-free** ammo on **City of Laramie Property**.
- Hunters may receive either a **Monolith** or a **Spiegelberg Ranch HMA** antelope permission slip. **Not Both**

- Please fill out carcass coupon and landowner coupon. If harvested on deeded land, please deposit the landowner coupon in any coupon box on the HMA or mail to the appropriate landowner.

- CWD samples: Hunters are reminded the Department is collecting CWD samples from deer and elk.

DEFINITIONS:

- **TAKE:** Means hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill, or posses, or attempt to hunt, pursue, catch, capture, shoot, fish, seine, trap, kill or possess.
- **Established road:** means any road or trail that has been graded or constructed to carry motor vehicles or on which repeated motor vehicle traffic has created well defined tracks.
- **Designated road:** means only established roads that are marked with a white arrow sign as open to motor vehicles. Roads not marked with a white arrow sign are **closed** to motor vehicles.
- **Wet or muddy road:** all roads are closed when conditions are wet or muddy.
